



## Some Guidelines for Church Stalls

- To help you focus, think of ONE thing to showcase. Something that your church does, is involved with, passionate about, committed to, good at, wants to celebrate.
- Creativity and visual effect are a bonus, but we are friends and family gathering together and no one is expecting perfection. Simple is fine.
- Think about how others can interact with it, remembering this is an All Age event. A game, a quiz, something to do or make, something to eat, something you can offer.
- You will probably have quite a small space, about 2m x 2m with a small table (about 65cm x 65cm) and a chair provided. You are welcome to bring other things as necessary.
- A small number of display boards will be available.
- Each church will have an A4 name card to tape to the table.
- Some power sockets will be available, but not for every church
- Please create/bring any leaflets or handouts which others would find helpful.
- Ideally please ensure someone is available on your stall to talk to people from about 11am-1.30pm.
- Stalls can be set up on Friday or early Saturday (by 10am). Stewards should be available to help unload cars at the west or north door.
