A reminder that the Autumn Diocesan Synod takes place at St Paul's & St George's Church on **Thursday 26th October** starting at **5.30pm** with Eucharist. Notification of Business will be issued at the end of September.

Funding Update

The Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme website has been redeveloped.

The redeveloped site includes **a new online application portal**. It follows the same format as the existing PDF form but will be easier to process than downloading and completing a physical document. The option to use the old PDF version will remain, but the application portal is planned to be more efficient, with all the information and attachments uploaded and submitted in one place. https://listed-places-of-worship-grant.dcms.gov.uk/
"The Listed Places of Worship (LPW) Grant Scheme gives grants covering the VAT on repairs of over £1,000 to listed buildings used as places of worship. You can also submit one claim in any 12-month period that is less than £1.000, but more than £500."
