Administrators. Do encourage anyone you might have in your congregation who might have such a role in your administration — other than your Vestry Secretary.


#### **Forms**

Could all Incumbents and Priests in Charge note that the annual **Congregational Statistics** will soon be due for "the year ending on the eve of Advent Sunday" which is **Sunday 3rd December**. All the numbers can be prepared now, except for the attendance on "the Sunday next before Advent".

In addition, we will soon send out the **Diocesan Schedules** for you to let us know any changes to your Vestry personnel etc., if you haven't already done so. This is intended to align with many of your AGMs which take place mostly in the Autumn.

There will be no Provincial Safeguarding Annual Return for this year as GSO are reevaluating the process in light of new legislation being implemented in 2024. The Diocese will be sending out a simple checklist to assist Vestries in maintaining safeguarding best practice.

#### **Safeguarding**

PVG Safeguarding Training Events in November and December In conjunction with John Wylie (the Provincial Safeguarding Officer) we are delivering five training events in November and Early December. Evening events start at 4pm and Saturday events will start at 10am.

This training has already been delivered in the Diocese of Glasgow and Galloway and has been subject to very positive feedback. Each session consists of facilitated discussion of key issues in Safeguarding, along with a series of practical scenarios, with each scenario building upon attendee's knowledge. The overall aim is to improve levels of confidence and to make it clear that help is always available.

It is very important that Coordinators attend this training. Feeling equipped and safe will help you to help and support others. In addition, significant changes to PVG legislation create criminal offences for both individuals and churches if processes are not adhered to. This training will help to support all vestries with these issues.
