Spring Synod and Area Councils

The Spring Diocesan Synod will be held on Saturday 24th February 2024 at St Paul's & St George's Edinburgh. The publication of business will be 4 weeks before (as required by the Canons), by Friday 29th January. Area Councils may wish to set their meeting dates for sometime between 30th January and 23rd February.

Please note that there will be elections to General Synod and various Provincial Committees etc. And we will let you know which vacancies exist, and the nomination deadlines, around the time that the Synod business is published.

Register of Controlling Resources in Land

New legislation requires registration, by 3 I March 2024, details of those responsible for ownership and/or control of land in Scotland.
