Provincial Green Grants

Over the last month the Diocesan Buildings
Committee has received a number of applications
for Provincial Buildings Grants which include work
to improve energy efficiency etc. Several were
prefaced that the basis for the application was due
to having heard that "grants were available for
Carbon Zero projects". We know that they will be
available soon, but any applications at this point are
premature. All we know at present from the
Province is:

"It is currently anticipated that new grant application forms and process will be introduced in April. There will be two new forms — one specifically for work to rectories, the other for work to all other church buildings. We are hoping to hold a Zoom meeting in the second half of April to provide an opportunity for dioceses to learn more about the new funds, forms and process"

Until we have attended that meeting, we will not know anything about the process or what the financial commitment of the diocese might be. We will let you know (here) as soon as we know ourselves.
