<u>People Know How</u> will facilitate 50 events in rural communities across Scotland to provide people with the information they need to prepare for the <u>PSTN</u> (<u>Public Switched Telephone Network</u>) switch-over.

Their Digital Support Helpline has also expanded its offerings to include free support and advice with the switch-over.

People Know How is currently open to expressions of interest from community organisations interested in delivering one of these events in local authorities outside of major cities.

You can find them on the free Keep Safe Scotland phone app or just look out for the window sticker which will be on display in all keep safe places.
