St Fillan's Bike rack

On 3rd October, the Diocese of Edinburgh celebrated a unique event with the blessing of a bike rack at St Fillan's, Buckstone. Bishop John led the blessing, while Ian Murray MP, Edinburgh South's representative and Secretary of State for Scotland, officially opened the rack. This project, supported by a National Lottery Community Fund grant, was brought to life through over 100 volunteer hours, reflecting the church's dedication to sustainability and community involvement. Bishop John said "a valuable contribution to sustainable transport, the bike rack is symbolic of St Fillan's welcome to the wider community and its care for creation."
