Net Zero - Rectories

The Provincial Net Zero Team are working hard across the Province to help vestries to get schemes underway.

Our own link NZ Team member, <u>Neil Rawlins</u>, has now attended a Diocesan Buildings Committee meeting, along with Andrew Aveyard, Convenor of our <u>Diocesan Environmental Group</u>. They are currently looking at

Rectories and their **Energy Performance Certificates** (EPCs). 13 Rectories do not currently have an EPC and we need to set a 'baseline' for each one so that we can see how Net Zero works (and grants) are making a difference — or not! The Diocesan Office will be in touch with those 13 Rectors soon, as the cost of getting them done can be **covered by a diocesan grant**. Warm Rectors are a good thing!
