Free First Aid Training

St Peter's, Lutton Place, and retired GP Dr Janice Allister (NUCO-certified First Aid Instructor) are offering FREE first aid training to churches. The training consists of 2 sessions, both of which must completed for certification: <u>Resuscitation</u> (CPR, defibrillation, anaphylaxis, choking) and <u>Basic First Aid</u> (bleeds, breaks, burns, falls, faints). These sessions will take place in St Peter's between 9am and 12noon: dates are below. Advanced booking, via email, is essential.
